Christmas Bird Count Editorial Codes and Database Flags

Two-letter codes are often used by regional editors to better explain or question a given record. Database flags can be set by compilers and regional editors to indicate an unusual species, high count, or low count. This list will aid you in deciphering the keys when reading accounts in the summaries and on the web site.

Summary of Highest Counts of Individuals for Canada

Canadian counts reported 289 species on the 106th Christmas Bird Count, down 11 from last year. Two species were added to the Canadian CBC list—**Buller's Shearwater** at Hecate Strait, British Columbia, and **Le Conte's Sparrow** at Kingston, Ontario. The national list now stands at 405.

British Columbia led the way as usual, with 161 high counts, followed by Ontario with 87, and Nova Scotia with 36. Victoria, British Columbia, had the highest number for a single count, with 35, followed by Ladner, British Columbia (21), Halifax-Dartmouth, Nova Scotia (12), and Cedar Creek, Ontario (11).

Twenty-nine of the high counts are all-time Canadian highs (not counting the new species mentioned above; numbers boldfaced below). Italics indicate those totals (64 species) that are highs for North America as well as Canada.

Various weather patterns again influenced results of individual counts, but total species reported by state was very similar to last year despite some periods of severe weather on both the Pacific and Gulf coasts. In all, 652 species were reported, with 47 being all-time highs (boldfaced numerals). An additional 35 infraspecific forms were reported, along with 25 exotic species. **Baikal Teal** and **Redwing** were new for United States Christmas Bird Counts. Overall, 42 states and 313 CBCs had at least one national high.

A significant proportion of the species reported here are represented in very small numbers—20 percent of the species have 10 or fewer birds, and 6 percent have only one bird. It would be easy to speculate how weather, numbers and skills of observers, access to key habitats, etc. influence results, but at the end of the CBC season most species are found nationally, and the year-end tally does not vary greatly from year to year.

However, the bird-finding factors mentioned above can have great influences on the success of individual counts. This season **Matagorda County-Mad Island Marsh, Texas**, led the nation for the fifth year in a row (8 out of the last 10 CBC seasons) with the highest counts of 30 species and one infraspecific form. Waipi'o, HI, came in second, with 14 species and one form, followed by Portal, AZ, with 12 species. Waimea, HI, had 11 species and one form; Zellwood-Mount Dora, FL, and Laysan Island, HI, had 11 species each; Tucson Valley, AZ, Point Reyes Pen., CA, and Guadalupe River Delta-McFaddin Family Ranches and Weslaco, TX, had nine species each. Carefree and Patagonia, AZ, along with California's Monterey Peninsula, Rancho Santa Fe, Santa Cruz County, and San Diego, as well as Midway Atoll, HI, had seven species each. The remainder of the CBCs had six or fewer national highs.

California reclaimed its normal first place in the states with 123 species and

seven infraspecific forms. Texas came in a close second with 119 species and two forms, followed by Florida with 82 species and two forms. The Hawaiian Islands had 66 species and five forms, Arizona had 64 species and three forms, Alaska had 31 species and one form, Washington had 19 species and two forms, Massachusetts had 18 species, Virginia had 12 species, New Mexico and Oregon each had 11 species, and Louisiana and Minnesota had 10 species. All other states had nine or fewer national highs.

Only counts for resident species, infraspecific forms, and exotics that do not have editorial comments questioning the validity of the results were accepted for this report. High counts for exotics without known established populations are displayed, but are added to results for CBC or state. If I make a mistake with this review of the 106th CBC, please let me know, and I will include corrections next year at the end of the column.
