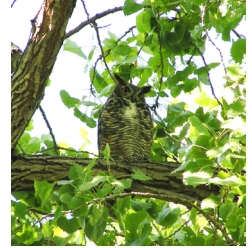


The Randall Davey Audubon Center, Wild birds Unlimited Santa Fe & The Nature Conservancy present:

Classes will be offered in a fun and interesting format on the 3rd Thursday of the month, followed by Saturday field sessions. Thursday evenings will be indoors (6:30-8:30 pm) & Saturday sessions will be in the field (8:30 am).



MARCH 19 & 21: Beginning Birding—the basics on equipment, books & how to identify birds

APRIL 16 & 18: Spring Migration—those amazing warblers & their friends. Learn about why birds migrate, their routes and which birds you can expect to see this month.

MAY 21 & 23: Spring Migration Continues—more spring birds & early nesters; more interesting flycatchers, warblers, tanagers and grosbeaks are here!!

JUNE 18 & 20: Summer Nesting Birds—nesting birds, the different kinds of nests, as well as how & where to find them

JULY 16 & 18: Hummingbirds—Dan True, author Hummingbirds of New Mexico will speak about those beautiful, speedy pollinators & what flowers they enjoy.

AUGUST 20 & 22: Riparian Birds—how to hear & find these interesting river-related birds

SEPTEMBER 17 & 19: "The Life and Times of New Mexico Raptors" with Hawks Aloft. Join Gail Garber, Director of Hawks Aloft for this amazing presentation with live birds, then hike in the watershed looking for raptors and fall migrating birds.

OCTOBER 15 & 17: Owls: Katherine Eagleson from the Wildlife Center will present a program on these amazingly adapted stealth-hunters. She will bring several species of live owls for us to see as well.

NOVEMBER 19 & 21: Waterfowl, shorebirds, ducks & geese, "dabblers and divers". Learn how to ID these birds; then we'll go looking for them on Saturday.

We'll also have a special raffle for some great gifts. Join us if you can.
